In October 2015, Lynda was responsible for the landmark visit of President Xi Jinping of China and Prime Minister David Cameron to Airport City and Manchester Airport, successfully launching the £130m China Cluster developments, along with a new direct route to Beijing.

Lynda joined from Scottish Widows Investment Partnership where she held the role of director of real estate. Lynda has previously headed Co-operative Estates and had roles at Lloyds Banking Group and BT, where she worked for 18 years.
