

DEMAND FOR OFFICE SPACE
CONTINUES WITH 720 sqm OF
COMMERCIAL SPACE IN CITY CENTRE
TO COMPLETE BY 2025

c.30,000 new residents expected in the city centre by 2030 (35% increase to 100,500)

Resident base diversifying incl. more people staying for longer – number of 35-49 year olds expected to double by 2030














City Centre – Expanding in All Directions
