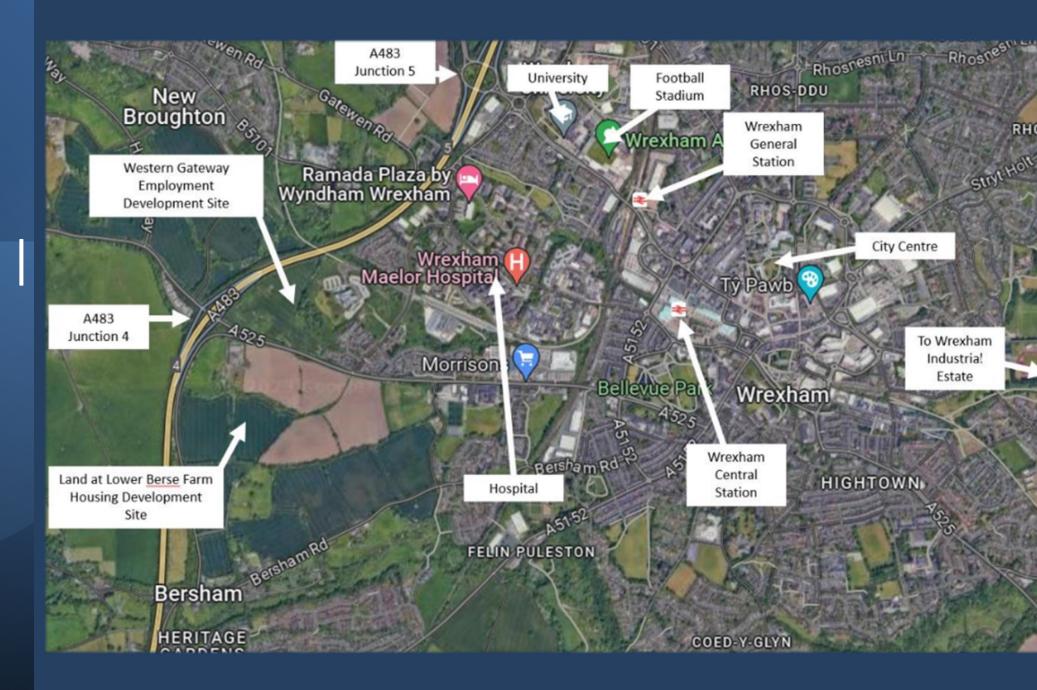

Key Objectives and Project Scope:

£9.1m of Capital funding has been allocated to deliver serviced employment sites for private sector developers.

This funding will deliver the following:

- Delivery to the market of 5 ha serviced employment land for future employment projects.
- Generate private sector capital investment with the provision of modern business premises.
- Create the environment of up to 550 FTE jobs.
- Employment development at Western Gateway a protected employment site for high quality B1 and B8 use.
- Active travel works to encourage modal shift.

Next Steps:

Commercial Property Development Grant

This Commercial Property Development Grant is aimed at addressing the viability gap for private sector developers of speculative or non-speculative industrial and/or office property in North Wales.

This funding will also be available for public sector partners to develop similar projects on a Joint Venture Agreement basis.

This proposal will provide additional funding into the existing Welsh Government Commercial Property Development Grant which is administered by the Development Bank for Wales.

The Joint Venture Agreement approach will build on the model developed for existing projects in the Programme with partners contributing land, capital and professional teams to develop the projects.
